I, Christos Valtzoglou, the Vice President and general manager of 128 Mac Corp. (the "Applicant"), which owns and operates Pylos Restaurant at 128 East 7th Street, New York, NY 10009 (the "Establishment"), represents that there has been no change to the Method of Operation previously approved by Community Board 3 and agrees to be bound by the Method of Operation previously approved by Community Board 3 and the NYS Liquor Authority.

Applicant seeks a change in class from Restaurant Wine (341) to On Premises (252) liquor to accommodate its patrons.

The Establishment has a certificate of occupancy for 70 people, 26 tables and 64 seats without a bar. Greek and Mediterranean food is prepared in a full kitchen, serving food during all hours of operation, no televisions, ambient recorded background music.

There are 26 full On Premises liquor licenses within 500 feet per the SLA LAMP map, but it does not appear that any are on the same block as the Establishment.

Pylos has operated at this location continuously for 19 years since July 2003 with a Restaurant Wine license Serial No.: 1140592 and its hours of operation are 11:30 am to midnight Wednesdays, Thursdays and Sundays, from 5 pm to 1 am on Fridays and Saturdays, and the restaurant is closed on Mondays and Tuesdays.






FRONT ELEVATION 128 East 7th Street New York, NY April 8, 2022
