**SAUDIS AND RUSSIA AGREE TO OIL CUTS, IN JAB AT THE WEST**

SAUDI ARABIA and Russia agreed on Wednesday to cut oil production by 2 million barrels a day, a move that analysts expect will push oil prices higher and help to stabilize the global economy.

The deal, announced by Saudi Arabia's energy minister and Russia's foreign minister, is seen as a major step toward resolving the oil market's supply glut and price volatility.

Analysts expect the cut to take effect in November, when global oil demand is expected to be at its highest.

The move is seen as a jab at the West, particularly the United States, which has been pushing for a more open and competitive oil market.

The deal is also seen as a sign of cooperation between the two nations, which have been at odds in the past.

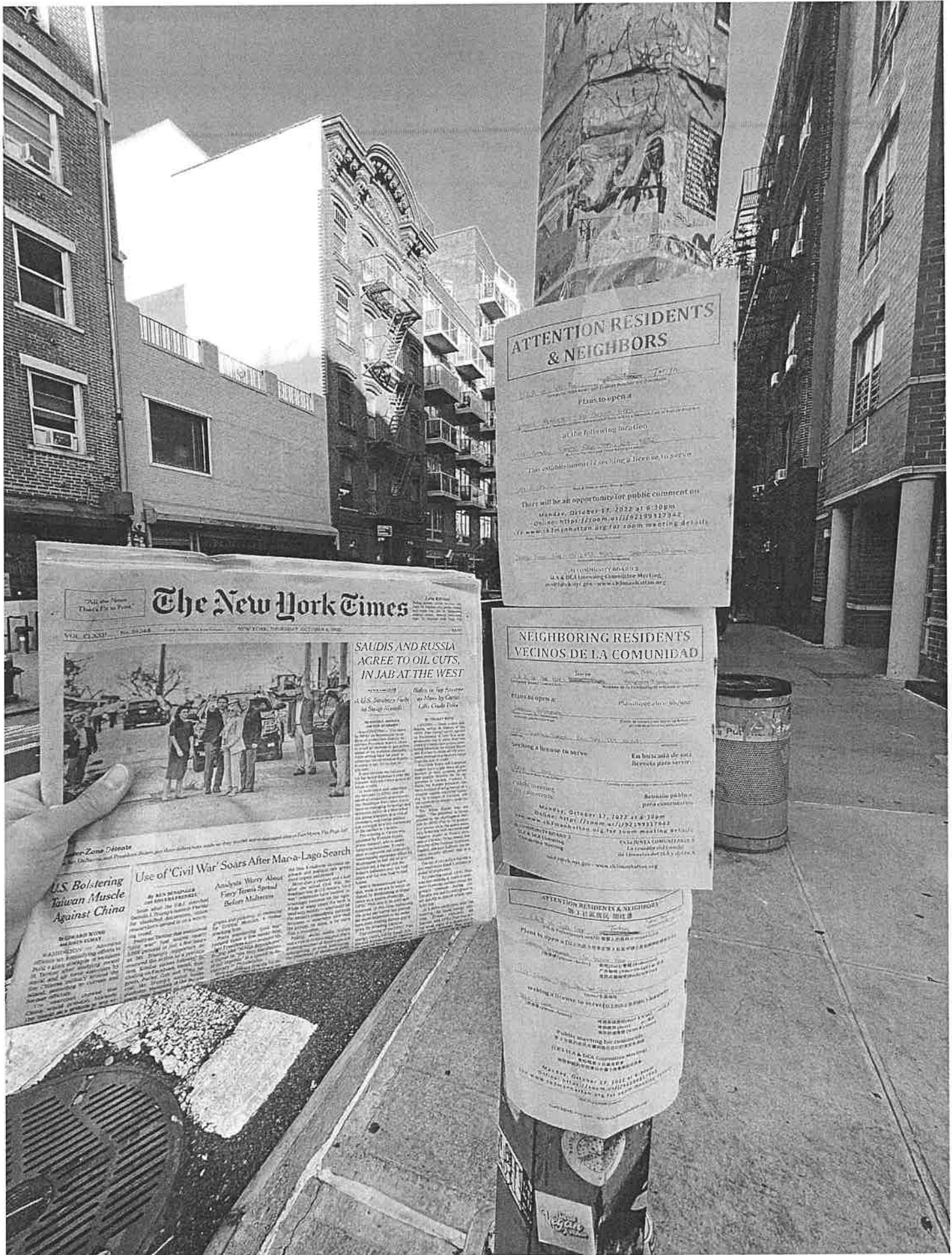

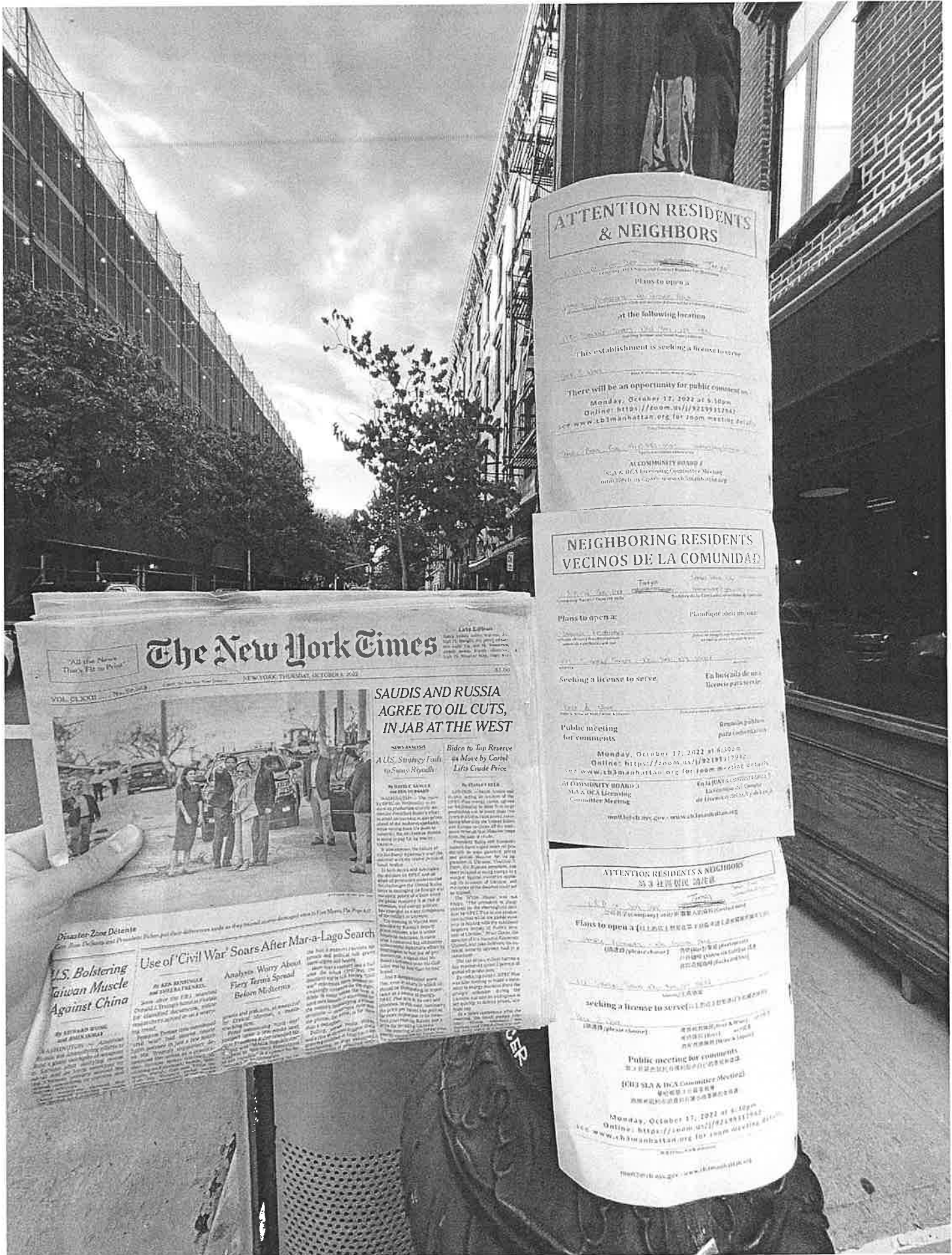

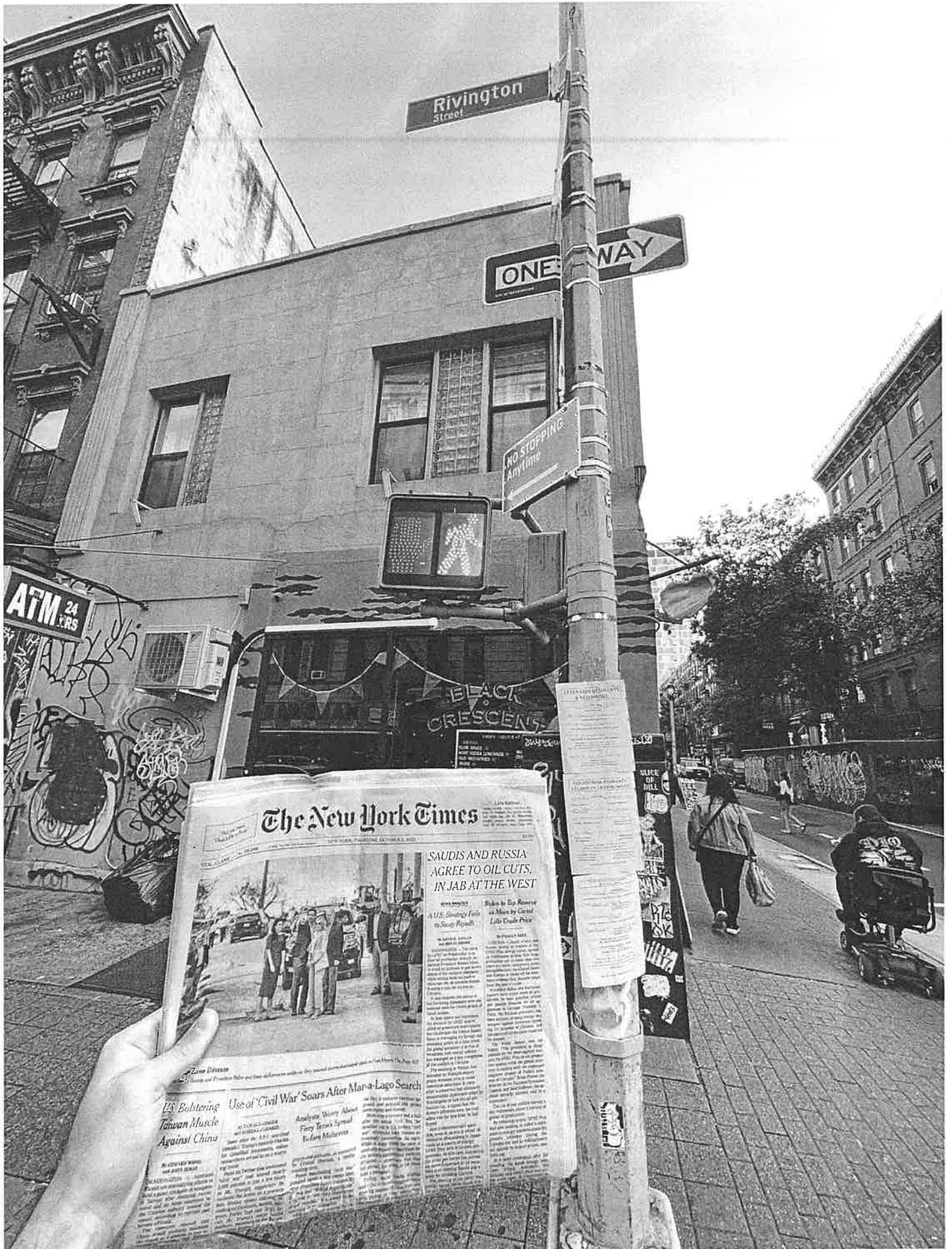
