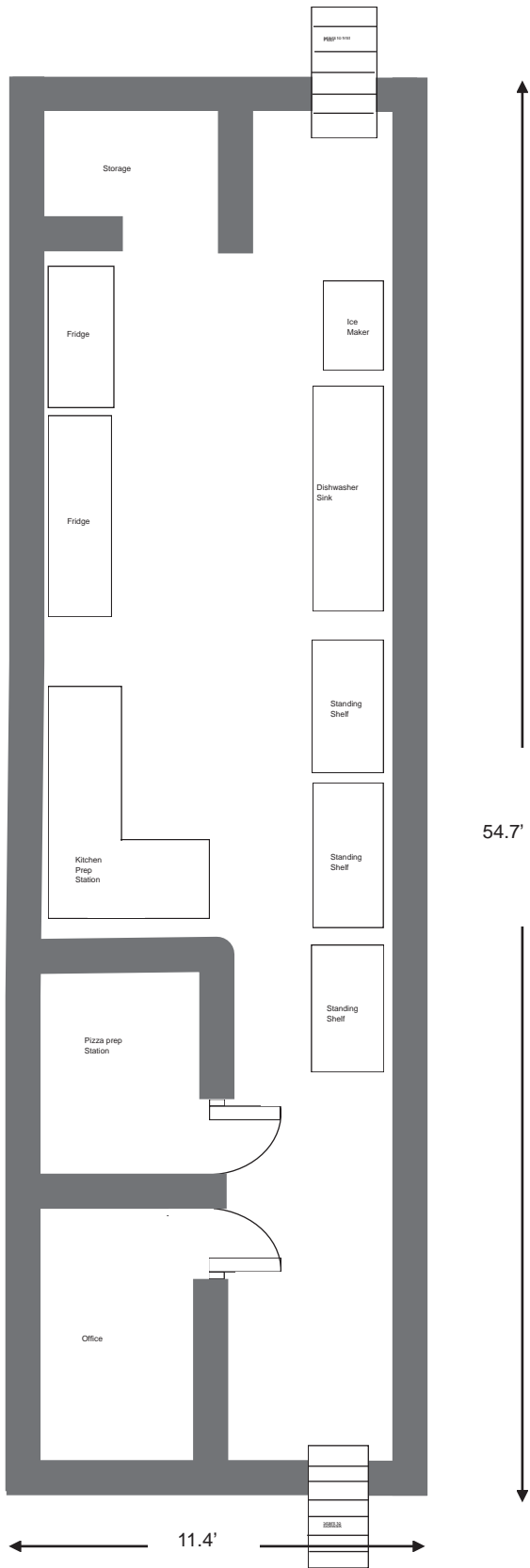




First Floor

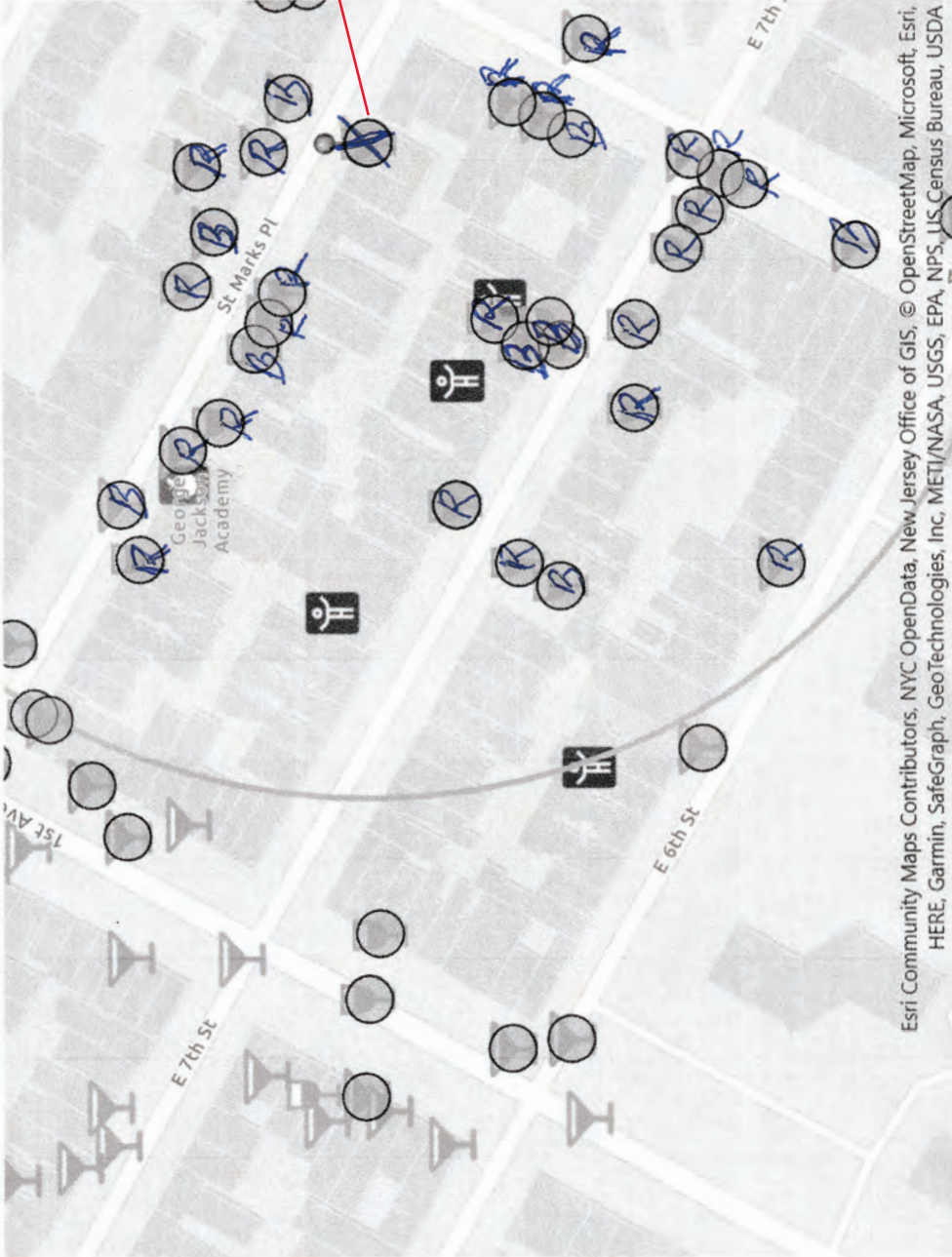
