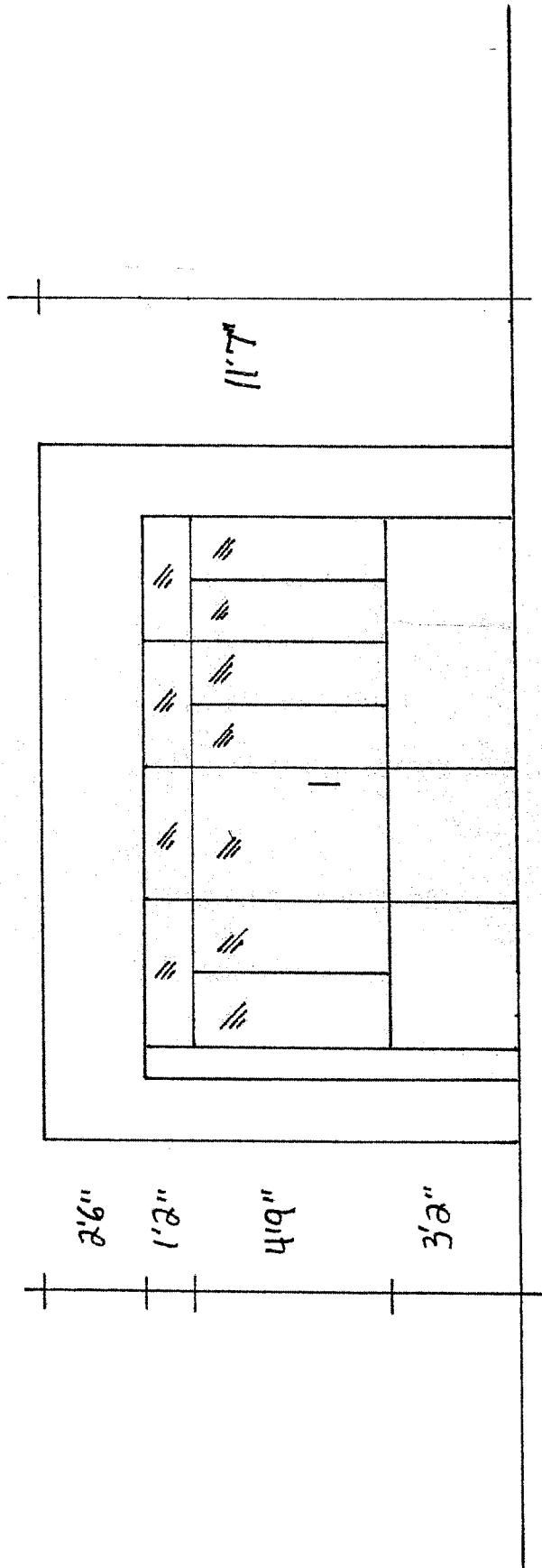

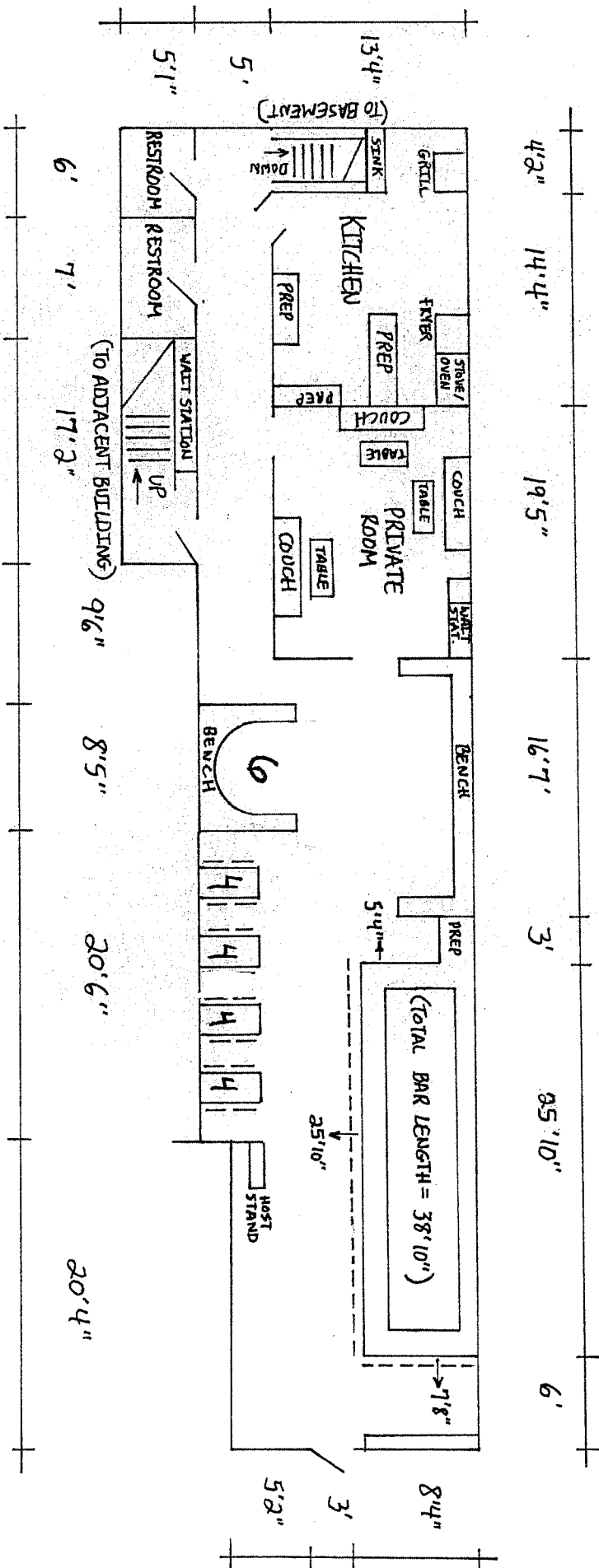

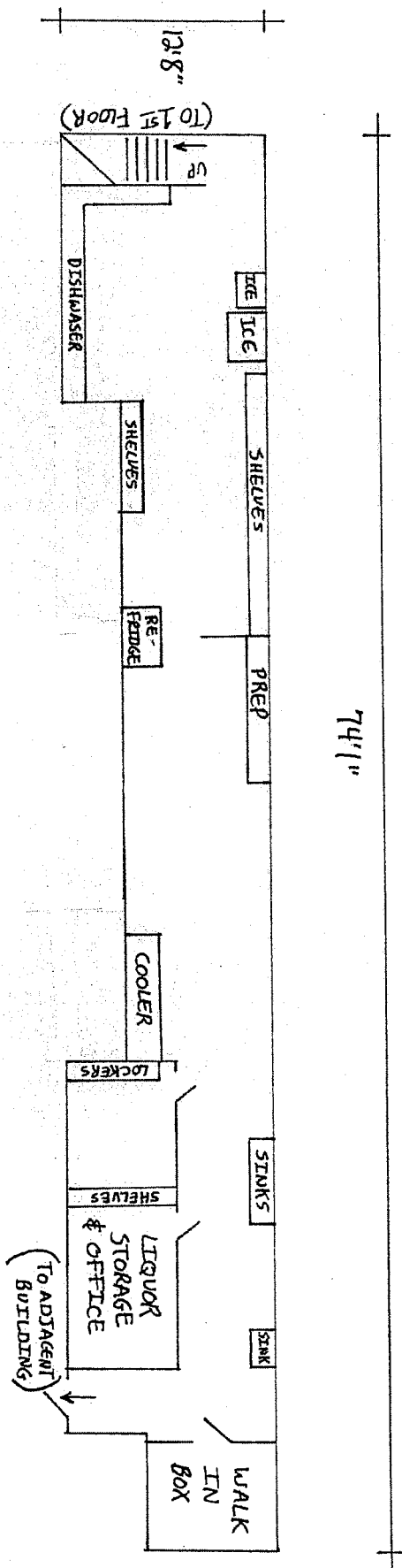


INTERIOR DIAGRAM

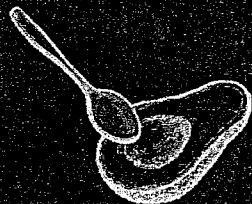
