

Block Plot Diagram



My name is Jon Neidich, and I head up Golden Age Hospitality, a bar/restaurant group in New York City. We own and operate several properties downtown, including Le Dive (on the Lower East Side), The Happiest Hour (in the West Village), and Deux Chats (in Brooklyn). We're currently in the process of applying for an asset transfer of a liquor license (under the applicant name LUCYSNYC LLC) for the bar Lucy's at 135 Ave A. The bar has been owned and operated by Ludwika "Lucy" Mikevicius since 1980.

While we are taking over the operation of the bar, our involvement is solely premised on preserving an East Village institution: Lucy herself will very much still be a part of this project (and will still be behind the bar!).
