



Our law firm represents Cavan NYC Hospitality Inc., an entity owned by Eugene Lennon. Our client has submitted a 30 Day Notice to Manhattan Community Board No. 3 (CB3) because it intends to file an application to the New York State Liquor Authority for a liquor license to be sited at 51 1st Avenue (presently occupied by Karma Sutra). As you may know, this location has been previously licensed with a full on-premises license since the 1970's. Our client will operate a very different concept than Karam Sutra instead operating an Irish style gastropub similar to one of Mr. Lennon's other locations in CB3, the Mayfly. Our client will be seeking 2:00 am closing hours Sunday through Thursday and 4:00 am Friday and Saturday. There will be no outdoor area. Our client will meet with CB3's SLA & DCA Licensing Committee at its April meeting. 
