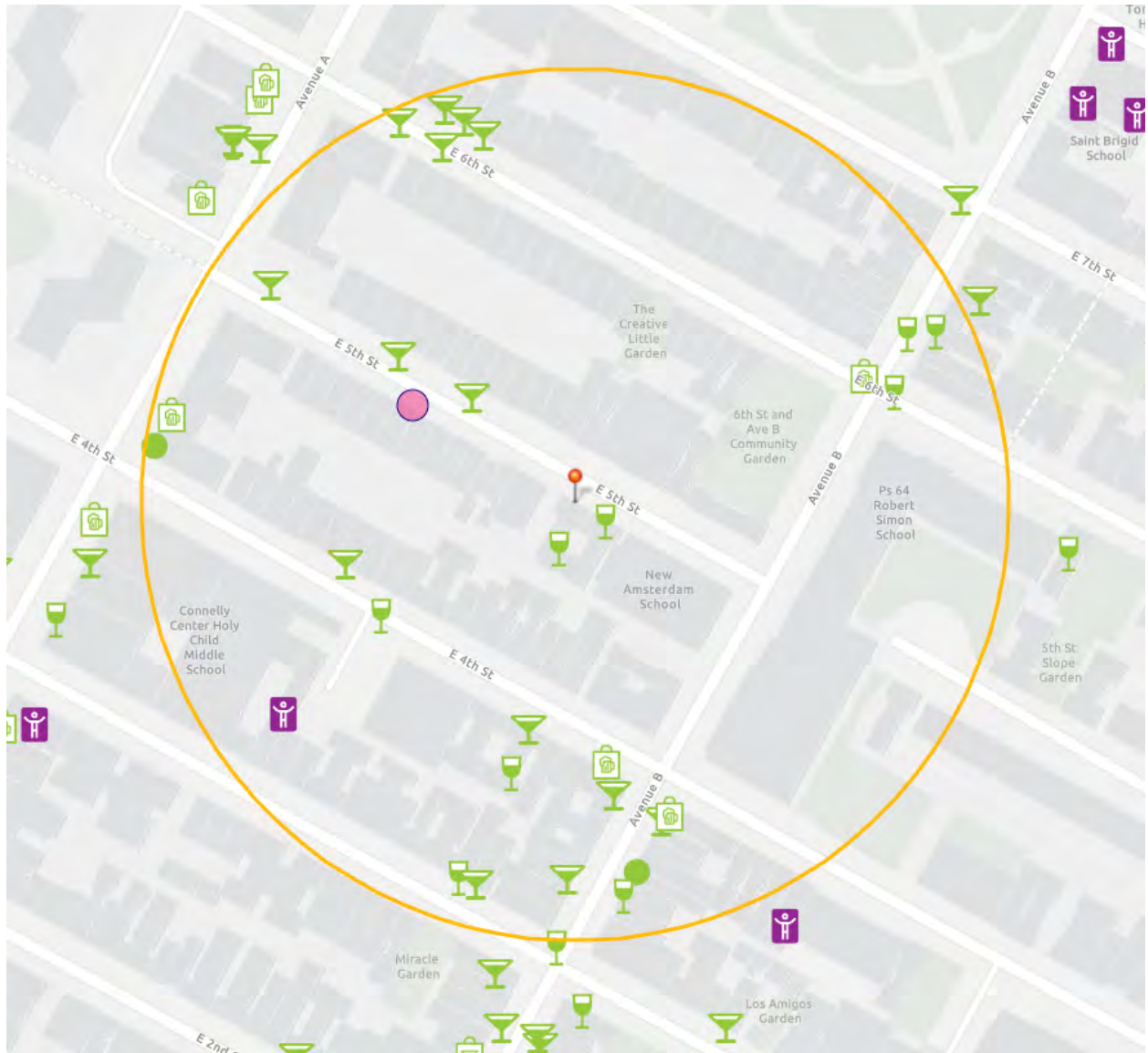

In 2018, Odo became independent and opened his eponymous restaurant, Odo, featuring a contemporary approach to Kaiseki cuisine. He also opened his HALL, featuring creative cocktails and a wagyu hamburger menu.

In 2020, in the midst of the pandemic, he launched MUSE, a sushi delivery service, and THE GALLERY opened in 2021 as a creative zone with the unique concept of fusing cuisine and art (or “interfacing between food and art”).

In 2023, he introduced his latest concept, Odo LOUNGE—a speakeasy-style, exclusive bar. Today, Chef Odo operates all five of his uniquely distinct establishments in Manhattan. Since 2023, he has also served as a Japanese Cuisine Goodwill Ambassador (日本食普及親善大使), appointed by Japan’s Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF).
