

## Open Street Program

New York City's Open Streets program transforms streets into public space open to all. These transformations allow for a range of activities that promote economic development, support schools, and provide new ways for New Yorkers to enjoy cultural programming and build community. NYC DOT works with community-based organizations, public, private, and charter schools, and groups of businesses to execute Open Streets citywide. NYC DOT's [Public Space Programming](#) effort helps bring engaging activities to public spaces throughout the city. All activities are free and open to New Yorkers of all ages and abilities.
