

# Renewing the Rotunda

Pedestrian Reroute


The NYC Department of Transportation, on behalf of the NYC Department of Parks and Recreation, is rehabilitating the West 79th Street Rotunda Complex within Riverside Park. The complex includes the Henry Hudson Parkway/ W. 79th Street traffic interchange, the W. 79th Street Bridge over Amtrak, and pedestrian and cyclist access to the park.

## PEDESTRIAN REROUTE


To maintain the safety of the community and park users, pedestrians will be rerouted around the construction site and staging areas.

- All paths shown in red, including the paths along W. 79th Street, will be closed.
- The green path along the north side will remain open for safe access from the community, through the Rotunda, to the esplanade.

Open paths will remain illuminated, the staging area will be fenced in, and signs will be posted to indicate pedestrian routes.



## THROUGH THE ROTUNDA



To access the Hudson River Greenway, follow marked paths to pass under the Henry Hudson Parkway, down the stepped ramp along the north side of the Rotunda, through the Pedestrian Plaza level, to the waterfront esplanade.

All temporary traffic and pedestrian patterns installed during construction may change as needed and construction progresses.
