The following facts and concerns were taken into account in arriving at our conclusion:

- 23 West 73rd Street was converted from a residential hotel to a condominium. The building continues to have hotel-like services for its residents.
- DOT removed the No Parking signs in front of the building following the conversion, and now finds there are significant safety issues on the block and the signs should not have been removed.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Community Board 7/ Manhattan urges DOT to restore a 3car length "No Parking Anytime" zone in front of the Park Royal on West 73rd Street.



Date: January 3, 2017 Committee of Origin: Transportation Re: West Side Federation of Senior and Supportive Housing, West 106th Street. Full Board Vote: 38 In Favor 0 Against 0 Abstentions 0 Present Committee: 9-0-0-0. Non-Committee Board Members: 4-0-0-0.

The following facts were taken into account when formulating this resolution:

- Many senior citizens cross West 106th Street mid-block between Red Oak Senior Housing and Jewish Home Lifecare at all hours of the day.
- Many choose to cross mid-block due to the long length of the block.
- Due to the hilly nature of the block, it is difficult for motorists to see pedestrians crossing, and due to the speed of some vehicles, cars come barreling into the mid-block, narrowly avoiding hitting pedestrians.
- There is a lot of support for this mid-block traffic signal, both from residents and elected officials representing the area.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Community Board 7/Manhattan requests the NYC Department of Transportation immediately take steps to install a mid-block traffic signal and crosswalk to allow pedestrians a safe crossing of West 106th Street, Columbus to Amsterdam Avenues, in front of the Red Oak Senior Housing, and further requests striping to clearly delineate the pedestrian crossing zone.
