NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION

No. 1: IN THE MATTER of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to utilize a different procedure, to negotiate a significant Sole Source License Agreement with Third Sector New England, Inc. (on behalf of the Worker's Justice Project) for the renovation, operation, and maintenance of Street Deliveristas Hubs to primarily serve New York City's food delivery workers at up to three sites, depending on available funding, including at Rose Hill Park in the Bronx, and City Hall Park and West 72nd Street & Broadway in Manhattan.

NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF SMALL BUSINESS SERVICES

No. 2: IN THE MATTER of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to allow NYC & Company Inc., on behalf of the NYC Department of Small Business Services, to utilize a different procedure to enter into a license agreement with Only NY Inc. for a non-significant concession for the non-exclusive use of city-owned trademarks on merchandise.
