NYC Tourism + Conventions, Inc. (NYC Tourism)/SBS is requesting authorization to utilize a different procedure, pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to negotiate a sole source agreement with Chinos Intermediate 2, LLC. DBA J.Crew Group, LLC for the non-exclusive use of City-owned trademarks on apparel and accessories. J. Crew, a New York based business, has been in business for over 40 years and caters to men, women, and children. J. Crew has formed strategic partnerships throughout its history to drive growth and innovation. Some notable partnerships include a collaboration with iconic British footwear brand Dr. Martens. The company partnered with luxury brand Prabal Gurung for a limited-edition collection. J.Crew has also collaborated with other renowned designers and brands such as Sophia Webster, Timex, and Vans, among others. The first J. Crew store opened its doors in the South Street Seaport district of New York City. Now, with over 500 retail stores, J. Crew is a well-established brand, that brings a new set of clientele and national visibility to the City's licensing program. J.Crew is an international brand with an extremely high name recognition. This would open up our consumer base to people who do not regularly come to NYC or have access to purchase FDNY goods. By working with J.Crew we have the opportunity to expand our retail footprint nationally as well as expand our customer base. J. Crew does not source goods from outside manufacturers, therefore working directly with this licensee is required to be able to sell within their retail stores. For these reasons, it is in the City's best interest to negotiate a sole source agreement with Chinos Intermediate 2, LLC. DBA J.Crew Group, LLC.
