NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION

No. 1: **IN THE MATTER** of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval to utilize a different procedure, pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to negotiate a significant sole source concession agreement with the Union Square Partnership Inc., for the maintenance and operation of Union Square Park in Manhattan. Parks anticipates that the agreement will allow the Partnership to retain a share of revenue from various permit fees and concessions, as defined in the agreement, to help offset their expenditures in Union Square Park.
