NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF SMALL BUSINESS SERVICES

No. 1: IN THE MATTER of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval to utilize a different procedure, pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to allow New York City Tourism + Conventions, on behalf of the New York City Department of Small Business Services, to negotiate a non-significant sole source license agreement with Good Speed, Inc. for the non-exclusive use of City-owned trademarks on merchandise.

No. 2: IN THE MATTER of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval to utilize a different procedure, pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to allow New York City Tourism + Conventions, on behalf of the New York City Department of Small Business Services, to enter into a significant sole source license agreement with Knowlita, LLC for the non-exclusive use of City-owned trademarks on merchandise. The agreement shall commence on September 1, 2025, and shall continue through December 31, 2027, unless sooner terminated pursuant to the terms and conditions of the agreement. The parties shall have the option to renew the agreement on substantially the same terms and conditions for a period of two (2) additional years.
