(the "Open Space Alliance") for the operation, management, and maintenance of a pedestrian plaza located on Union Avenue between North 10th Street and North 12th Street in the Borough of Brooklyn ("Licensed Plaza"), including through DOT-approved events, sponsorships, and subconcessions, including but not limited to providing for the sale of any of the following: prepared food, flowers, locally grown produce or locally manufactured products, merchandise (such as souvenirs or T-shirts) that helps brand or promote the neighborhood or Open Space Alliance, and other similar merchandise within the Licensed Plaza
