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M/WBE Small Purchase Award Method Audit Review April 1st, 2025, through June 30st, 2025

For the period between April 1, 2025, and June 30, 2025, City agencies have utilized the M/WBE Small Purchase Award Method (SP) on 263 occasions, resulting in contract actions for 132 unique M/WBE vendors.

The awardees during the relevant period show M/WBE award categories disaggregated as follows:

In addition to the above performance metrics, MOCS audited and analyzed 10% of all contract actions registered during Q4 of FY'25 that were not procured using the M/WBE Small Purchase method. Upon reviewing and corresponding with the agencies, 33 contracts out of the 164-sample audit were identified as might have been appropriate to instead use the M/WBE Small Purchase method. These contracts have registration values of no more than \$100,000 each, and 20 contracts out of 33 were awarded to M/WBE vendors.

MOCS will continue to provide agencies with resources and M/WBE directories to help find adequate pool of certified and qualified M/WBE vendors for their program needs, if applicable.
