So the business before the meeting 7 today is to vote on proposed rules for 8 the Citywide Administrative Procedures 9 10 Act process, which we'll refer to as 11 CAPA for the purposes of the meeting. 12 The first item on the agenda relates 13 to the creation of a new small purchase 14 to allow agencies to make purchases from 15 minority and women-owned business 16 enterprises without formal competition. 17 For the purposes of the meeting, we'll continue to refer to these 18 19 enterprises as M/WBEs. 20 The Chair would like to now 21 recognize Acting Director of the Mayor's 22 Office of Contract Services, Dan Symon, 23 to speak further on this matter. 24 MR. SYMON: Good afternoon 25 everybody.

The Procurement Policy Board proposes to amend Chapter 3 of Title 9 of the Rules of the City of New York to create a new subtype of small purchase known as an M/WBE Noncompetitive Small Purchases.

The M/WBE Noncompetitive Small

Purchase mechanism will allow agencies

to make purchases of goods and services

from M/WBEs in amounts not exceeding

\$150,000 without competition.

This proposed rule is authorized by Charter Section 311(i)(1), added by Chapter 504 of the 2017 Laws of New York.

The text of this proposed amendment is described as Item 1 on today's agenda, which is featured on the calendar portion of the PPB web page.

Board is proposing amendments to Chapter
1 and Chapter 2 of Title 9 of the Rules
of the City of New York to escalate the
PASSPort enrollment, formally known as
VENDEX, threshold from \$100,000 up to
\$250,000.

The threshold for enrollment in PASSPort was already increased by the City Council through Local Law 72 of 2017 which amended Subsections 6-116.2(b) and (i) of the New York City Administrative Code.

This rule change seeks to bring the PPB Rules into alignment with the provisions of the Administrative Code.

This rule change also seeks to harmonize the use of the terms PASSPort and VENDEX, which describe the City's electronic vendor management system.

The text of this proposed amendment is featured as Item 2 on today's agenda.
