The proposed changes will amend
Chapter 3 of Title 9 of the Rules of the

City of New York to apply quantitative

bids to vendors certified with the City

or State of New York as minority or

women-owned business enterprises

pursuant to Article 15-A of the

Executive Law or Section 1304 of the New

York City Charter. Further, the proposed amendment allows the quantitative preference to be adjusted with the approval of the City Chief procurement officer.

Additionally, the proposed rule changes will similarly amend the provisions related to best value competitive sealed proposals and expanding its application to the quantitative M/WBE preference to professional services including construction-related consulting services.

Finally, the proposed rule change would amend Chapter 3 of Title 9 of the Rules of the City of New York to allow the M/WBE Noncompetitive Small Purchase Mechanism to be used for purchases up to \$500,000 for goods, services and construction.

The text of these PPB rule changes is featured on the PPB website and is included in the handout that was
