IN THE MATTER of the intent to seek Franchise and Concession Review Committee approval to utilize a different procedure, pursuant to Section 1-16 of the Concession Rules of the City of New York, to authorize the New York City Department of Parks and Recreation (Parks) to enter into a Sole Source License Agreement (Agreement) with the Prospect Park Alliance, Inc. (Licensee) for the operation of various food concessions, special events, short-term facility agreements, and catering services at Prospect Park, Brooklyn. These concessions are to include a snack bar at the Parade Ground; seasonal food truck events in Prospect Park; mobile food units throughout the year throughout Prospect Park; short-term facility agreements for recreational, educational, cultural and other similar parks-appropriate programs and services and catering services at the Audubon Center at the Boathouse and the Picnic House; and other such uses as may be approved in advance in writing by Parks. Parks, in its sole discretion, shall have the option to renew this Agreement for up to two (2) additional five (5)-year periods, provided that Parks has renewed the M&O Agreement for the same periods. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in no event will the total length of the term of this Agreement, including any renewal periods, exceed the shorter of (i) twenty (20) years; or (ii) the term of the M&O Agreement, including any renewal periods.
