

#### Dear Provider Partner,

The City of New York continues to keep you apprised of updates on the Indirect Cost Rate (ICR) Funding Initiative.

#### **INITIATIVE CLOSING IN 7 WEEKS**

- Only 3 Weeks Left! Final Deadline to Submit Entryway Choice Forms. The
  recommended deadline of November 1 has passed. Providers seeking to obtain an
  Accepted ICR effective Fiscal Year 2021 must complete an Entryway Choice Form
  by December 1, 2020. As a reminder, submitting an Entryway Choice Form means
  that a Provider has established an ICR in accordance with the Cost Manual and has inhand their Verification Documentation, as necessary, in the form of a Negotiated
  Indirect Cost Rate Agreement (NICRA) or Independent Accountant's Report.
- Does your organization need to submit an Entryway Choice Form for FY21 funding? Your organization should only submit an Entryway Choice Form if it a) received notification that it did not submit an accurate Delta Template in FY20 by the August 19 deadline, b) received an Accepted Conditional Template and ICR for FY20, or c) has yet to enter the ICR Funding Initiative since it opened in November 2019. Providers who have an Accepted ICR, or are in the FY20 sampling and testing process, do not need to resubmit an Entryway Choice Form for FY21.
- After December 1, the Entryway Choice Form will close. If your organization needs to submit an Entryway for FY21 funding but does not do so by December 1, your organization will revert to an Accepted ICR of 10% and will not receive additional funding through an ICR Amendment.
- 30-Day Submission Window for Delta Templates. The current timeline for providers
  to complete and upload their Delta Templates to their HHS Accelerator Document Vault
  is within 30 days of receipt from the CIT to facilitate timely and accurate amendment
  registration. An <u>instructional video</u> on completing the Delta Template, as well as other
  support resources, can be found on the <u>Indirect Implementation Webpage</u>.

## **FY20 AMENDMENT INFORMATION**

- No Negative Amendments. The City will not issue negative amendments in
  conjunction with this Initiative. In cases where the Accepted Delta Template indicates a
  negative amendment value for a particular contract, providers should work directly with
  the contracting City Agency to reallocate those costs to appropriate Direct Cost line
  items.

- FY20 ICR Amendment Calculator. The CIT has made available on the <u>Indirect</u> <u>Implementation Webpage</u> an <u>Excel worksheet</u> that providers with FY20 Accepted ICRs may use to calculate the value of their FY20 ICR Amendments.

## **BACKGROUND ON INITIATIVE**

In February 2019, the City of New York adopted the Cost Manual to standardize cost allocation practices for health and human service providers contracting with the City. The Fiscal Year 2020 Adopted Budget established an Indirect Cost Rate Funding Initiative based on the Cost Manual. The Fiscal Year 2021 Adopted Budget, passed during the COVID-19 pandemic, maintained the ICR Funding Initiative at an adjusted level of funding. The Mayor's Office of Management and Budget and Mayor's Office of Contract Services form the City Implementation Team (CIT), tasked to design and manage the implementation and roll-out of the Initiative. The CIT established a Provider Workgroup that includes City Council representation to advise them.
