Samaritan Village voluntarily re-allocated in full their funds for the "Young Mothers Project" back to the NYC CoC. The service provider and CoC are in agreement on this decision. Samaritan Village no longer wishes to receive HUD funding for this project, which can hopefully be used to fund proposed new and expansion projects. The CoC and Samaritan Village determined that the organization can draw upon other non-HUD funded projects and utilize other resources to provide quality services and supports to the residents in the "Young Mothers Project." The CoC formally granted this request via letter on November 1, 2021. Funding for the "Young Mothers Project" will end at the expiration date of the current contract and the New York City CoC will continue to work with Samaritan Village to limit any gap in services for clients in this program.
