Purpose

- Gauge project progress on meeting HUD and NYC goals to end homelessness
- Determine areas of project performance improvement
- Inform NOFO Planning and Priority Listing and Steering Committee strategic planning

2023 Annual Performance Evaluation Overview

Participants

- HUD CoC funded renewal projects
 - Projects in their 1st year of operation are exempt
 - Additional (2nd or 3rd year) exemptions on a case-by-case basis
 - Projects not renewed in annual NOFO are not evaluated

2023 Annual Performance Evaluation Overview

Components &

Scoring

HMIS Tool (~80% of total score)

- PSH 84 maximum points
- TH 79 maximum points
- RRH 82 maximum points
- TH-RRH TBD
- All projects evaluated on Federal Fiscal Year (10/1/21 – 9/30/22)

NYC CoC Local Priorities Survey (LPS) (~20% of total score)

- All projects: 23 points (+ 2 possible bonus = 25)
- All projects evaluated on their Contract Year (ending in CY 2022)

2023 Annual Performance Evaluation

HMIS Tool Highlighted Changes for 2023

Question 1: Unit Utilization

- Applies to RRH projects Only
- No longer based on average daily utilization rate. Now based on number served relative to NOFO and number placed into housing

• Question 5 and 6: Maintained or Increased EARNED and OTHER Income

- Applies to all projects
- Persons aged 67+ will no longer be included in the calculation for EARNED Income
- For Youth exclusive projects, if 90% maintain/increase EARNED Income, project receives 12 full points, and is exempt from OTHER Income metric

2023 Annual Performance Evaluation

HMIS Tool Highlighted Changes for 2023

Question 5 and 6: Maintained or Increased EARNED and OTHER Income

 For RRH Only – EARNED Income =12 points, OTHER Income = 6 points (Reversed from last year)

Question 9b: Exit to Permanent Housing

- For RRH Only Eliminated. Was not germane to RRH projects
- RRH projects will continue to be evaluated on Question 9c = 15 points (Previously was 10 points)

• Question 9d: Rate of Return to Homelessness

- For RRH Only Now Scored = 5 points (Previously was 10 points)
- If project exceeded benchmark (> 15% of clients), it will be asked to provide an explanation separately

PWLE

- Providers employ PWLE = 1 point
 - · Previously a Bonus Point
- Project employs PWLE = 1 Bonus point

CAPS

- Projects completing CAS Survey/SHA Application (Unscored)
- Project receives referrals (Unscored)

2022 NOFO Priorities

- Questions on racial equity, LGBTQ+, partnerships with public health organizations (Unscored)
- Compliance with HUD and CoC Policies = 1 point
 - · Previously Unscored
- HOPE Survey participation
 - Provider participation = 1 Bonus point

2022 NOFO Overview

HUD Priorities in FY22 NOFO

- Ending homelessness for all persons
- Using a Housing First approach
- Reducing Unsheltered Homelessness
- Improving System Performance
- Increasing Affordable Housing Supply
- Increased coordination with Housing, Health, and Service Agencies
- Increased emphasis on identifying and addressing racial disparities
- Improving Assistance to LGBTQ+ Individuals
- Increased emphasis on engagement of people with lived experience (PWLE)
