How to Support the Right to Vote for People Experiencing Homelessness

With the 2024 election nearing, the Alliance is supporting efforts to ensure that all people experiencing homelessness are able to access their right to vote. Below are some resources and three Steps to Supporting Clients' Right to Vote:

Step 1: Develop a Plan

Step 2: Voter Registration

- Gathering the Information Your Clients Will Need

Step 3: Vote

- Two Ways to Educate Clients on Candidates and Issues

To qualify for voter registration in New York State, you must:

- be a United States Citizen;
- be 18 years old (you may pre-register at 16 or 17 but cannot vote until you are 18);
- be a resident of this state and the county, city or village for at least 30 days before the election;
- not be in prison for a felony conviction;
- learn more about felon registration rights
- not be adjudged mentally incompetent by a court;
- not claim the right to vote elsewhere
