




Emergency Housing Vouchers Payment Standards Document

Description:


Emergency Housing Vouchers can pay more in many high-rent neighborhoods where housing may be difficult to find—without an increase in cost to the voucher holder. For example, EHVs may help pay for 1-bedroom apartments that rent for up to \$2,138 in Rego Park, Queens, and 2-bedroom apartments that rent for up to \$3,326 in Park Slope, Brooklyn.

The EHV Payment Standard Document handout can be printed in 12 languages to provide to clients potentially eligible in CAPS for EHV. There are several ways the document is made available in CAPS.

The EHV Payment Standards can be printed when the client receives potential eligibility for EHV, there is an automatic pop up when staff finalize the survey. See the screenshot below:
