Older Adult Homelessness

The number of adults experiencing homelessness who are 50 and older has risen faster than other groups. The report by UCSF Benioff Homelessness and Housing Initiative reviews who experiences homelessness in late life, how they lost their housing, their experiences during homelessness, and the barriers they face to regaining housing.



Uplift has opened its first-ever petfriendly homeless shelter

New York families can now bring their pets to a New York City shelter. Urban Resource Institute & NYC Department of Homeless Services have partnered to launch an innovative pet-inclusive pilot. The Uplift Families Residence in the Bronx has 161 units that can house approximately 587 people.

HMIS Updates

Federal HMIS Report Season Complete!

The HMIS team successfully submitted the LSA, SPM, and HIC PIT reports to HUD (<u>HUD</u> <u>Exchange</u>). HUD is expected to review and release these reports in the Fall.

2024 Annual NYC CoC Evaluation is Underway!
