

2023 NOFO Rapid Re-housing Quick Guide

CoC-funded Rapid Re-housing (RRH) is a pathway to permanent housing for individuals experiencing homelessness in New York City. RRH is a Housing First intervention designed to support households to quickly exit homelessness and establish a foundation for permanent housing success.



Core Components of Rapid Rehousing

1

Housing Identification

- Assistance in identifying & securing housing
- RRH clients sign a 12-month lease in their own name

2

Rental and Move-in Assistance

- Covers moving expenses (one-time)
- Rental assistance maximum of 24 months
- Can be used for security deposit, last month's rent, broker's fees

3

Case Management

- Client-driven & focused on long-term housing stability
- Should eliminate barriers to safe & stable housing through connections to supports



Applicant Requirements

- ✓ Eligible applicants for CoC RRH funding include non-profit organizations (including faith-based) and government agencies
- ✓ Applicants must be registered with <https://www.sam.gov/SAM> & must have a valid [UEI Number](#)



Who can RRH Programs Serve?

- ✓ RRH participants must fall under HUD homeless definition of literal homelessness (1), imminent risk (2), or fleeing DV (4)
- ✓ In NYC, priority is given to clients who are literally homeless or fleeing violence

- ✓ Rental Assistance (must be tenant-based)
- ✓ Supportive Services (for a full list of eligible activities, [see this page](#))
- ✓ Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) (For a full list of eligible activities, [see this page](#))
- ✓ Project Administration

What Makes RRH Different From Other Housing Programs?

- ✓ Fewer barriers to securing an apartment compared to city/federal voucher programs
- ✓ Rental assistance is time-limited but accompanied by supportive services throughout
- ✓ Due to time-limited nature of assistance, case management is focused on resource connections that support long-term housing stability
