Steering Committee Expectations

Steering Committee Co-Chairs

- A maximum of three co-chairs shall lead the Steering Committee. Not all Co-Chairs need be voting members of the Steering Committee. No more than two Co-Chairs shall be government representatives. One Co-Chair seat will be dedicated to the CoC Lead Agency and is not subject to the Co-Chair election process.
- Co-Chairs, excluding CoC Lead Agency Chair, shall serve staggered two-year terms.

Membership and Duties

- The Steering Committee is a 17-member body (see chart on page 2).
- Each Steering Committee representative must have at least one designated Alternate Representative. If neither can attend, a Proxy may be appointed at least 12 hours in advance of the meeting.
- Each NYC CoC committee must have at least one Steering Committee member represented.
- Steering Committee members may be recruited to serve on various ad-hoc committees or workgroups.

Meetings

- There will be 12 Steering Committee meetings each CoC year. Steering Committee members and/or their designated alternate must attend at least 9 (75%) of all Steering Committee meetings to remain in good standing.
- A quorum of 9 members must be met for any Steering Committee motion to be brought to order. In the event of a tie, the non-voting CoC Co-Chair shall have the determining vote.
