NYCHA Resident Roundtable Committee Overview

NYCHA's Transformation Plan can only be successful if it creates a true partnership between residents and employees.

The purpose of the Resident Roundtable is to create a formal role for resident participation in designing and informing the implementation of NYCHA's Transformation Plan. The Roundtable will enable resident led working groups as well as embed residents alongside NYCHA staff in project teams.

Resident Roundtable Committee Overview

Roundtable Committee's Composition

- RRC is comprised of 32 residents; 30 of which represent NYCHA's Neighborhood Portfolios. The remaining two members represent RAD/PACT developments.
 - 27 members were selected via an open application process amply advertised.
 - 5 members were appointed by CCOP.
- RRC is structurally divided into 4 Subcommittees of the top four topics identified in the Transformation Plan by the members:
 1. Quality of Life
 2. Quality Assurance
 3. Safety & Security
 4. Management Practices

Resident Roundtable Committee Overview

Scope of Work

- The Roundtable worked in subcommittees, each focusing on a distinct issue area

Example Duties

- Attended roundtable and committee meetings
- Solicited topical input from residents (including those under connected or unconnected from the internet or computer)
- Made recommendations to NYCHA on policy and programs
- Advised and actively participated in implementation of approved recommendations
- Participated on Transformation Plan implementation workstreams
- Participated in other areas of feedback where NYCHA would like to engage with residents
