- If selected, I will be available to serve full time from start date to end date.
- I will serve as a City Service Corps full-time member (an average of 40 hours per week) for approximately 10.5 months, to achieve a minimum of total number of service hours.
- I understand that the stipend for the City Service Corps service is \$total amount (pretax) for the entire term.
- I understand that a basic medical insurance plan will be available for City Service Corps members, at no cost to me, during my active term of service if I do not have other insurance.



 I understand that travel using public transportation may be required to and from my host site, and I will receive monthly unlimited MTA MetroCards during my active term of service.

<u>Note:</u> This opportunity is a full-time service experience. Applicants must be available to serve Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm at a minimum throughout the full service term. The City Service Corps program is contingent upon receipt of federal funds from the Corporation for National & Community Service and the New York State Commission on National & Community Service for the 2020-2021 program term.

Each term of service for which an individual earns an education award counts as one term of service in computing the term limitations. This includes terms for which a member earns a full-time, half-time, and any other type part-time or prorated education award. Generally, if a member is released before completing a term of service and does not receive the education award, that term counts as one of the terms served. Any corps member who has received the equivalent of two full-time education awards may be eligible to serve another term, but cannot receive an additional education award. If you have been enrolled in four AmeriCorps terms, you are not eligible to serve another term.
