

## **NEW YORK CITY WATER BOARD**

**PUBLIC NOTICE** is hereby given pursuant to Section 1045-j (3) of New York Public Authorities Law, that after a public hearing was held on May 31, 2019, the New York City Water Board, at a meeting held on June 14, 2019, adopted a resolution approving an increase in the rate charged for water provided to customers of the Water Supply System of the City of New York (the “City”) that are located north of the City. The following rate changes are effective as of July 1, 2019:

The regulated rate for water supply provided to users outside the City that is within the allowance quantities set forth in Section 24-360 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, has been increased from \$1,728.99 per million gallons (“MG”) to \$1,888.06 per MG; and

The rate for water supply provided to users outside the City that is in excess of the allowance quantities set forth in Section 24-360 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York has been increased from \$5,093.58 per MG to \$5,211.24 per MG.
