

NEW YORK CITY WATER BOARD

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT in accordance with Sections 1045-j (3) and 1045-j (9a) of the New York State Public Authorities Law, the New York City Water Board (the “Board”) held public hearings on June 1, 2, 3, and 4, 2026, followed by its annual meeting held on June 10, 2026, at which the Board adopted resolutions approving amendments to the Board’s Water and Wastewater Rate Schedule (the “Rate Schedule”) effective as of July 1, 2026 and additional amendments to the Board’s Billing Regulations. The amendments to the Rate Schedule include:

- (1) An increase of 6.0% to the metered and unmetered water and wastewater rates and rate-based billing programs for customers within New York City.
- (2) Reauthorization of the Home Water Assistance Program and the Multi-family Water Assistance Program, including bill credits of up to \$196 per eligible property and \$250 per eligible affordable apartment unit, respectively, and allowing up to 75,000 affordable apartment units to receive a Multi-family bill credit.
- (3) Extension of the administrative compliance deadline until June 30, 2027 applicable to accounts billed under the Multi-family Conservation Program.
- (4) Maintaining the minimum charge at \$0.49 per day for water service and wastewater at 159% of water charges.
- (5) Amendments to the Board’s policies with respect to customer billing adjustments resulting from unmetered billing and adjustments pursuant to the Leak Forgiveness Program.

The Board’s Billing Regulations subject to amendment include:

- (1) Amendments to the Board’s Billing Regulation Number 3, relating to the Board’s Denial of Access policies.
