

Scammers are convincing New Yorkers to send them GIFT CARDS for fraudulent reasons.



Signs that someone might be a victim of gift card fraud:



- Customer buys multiple gift cards, especially with high dollar values
- Customer seems distressed while purchasing gift cards
- Customer says they are purchasing gift cards to help a family member or pay their bills
- Customer takes pictures of the serial number immediately after purchase



Tips to protect your customers:

- Prominently post signs warning consumers about fraud near cash registers and gift card stands
- Limit the number/value of gift cards that may be purchased at one time
- Check that the PIN is not revealed – if it is, don't sell it
- Don't sell gift cards at self-checkout stands
- Encourage payments for gift cards via credit card, which can help with tracking
