RE: Expansion of DEP Cases to be Adjudicated by Mail, Internet or Telephone

Dear Director Kelpin:

On April 26, 2011, Julio Rodriguez, the Director of Tribunal Affairs of the New York City Environmental Control Board ("ECB") and you, on behalf of the New York City Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP"), met to discuss the adjudication of DEP cases returnable to ECB by alternatives to live hearings (the "Meeting"). Also present at the Meeting were Russell Pecunies, DEP Assistant Counsel, and ECB Director Amy Slifka.

48 RCNY 3-34 authorizes ECB to designate certain classes of alleged violations for adjudication by mail ("Mail Adjudication") and to prescribe procedures for such adjudications. ECB has prescribed procedures for Mail adjudication that includes hearings by mail, One Click hearings (internet), and hearings by telephone.

I am writing to confirm DEP's consent to Mail Adjudication for the 49 DEP violations listed below, which adjudication shall include, but not be limited to, hearings by mail, internet or telephone.
