- 21. OATH is conducting this hearing in accordance with the
- 22. requirements of the City Administrative Procedure Act also known as
- 23. CAPA. The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments from the

public on OATH's Proposed Rule to Amend 48 RCNY Section 24. 3-126, the Water Penalty Schedule. 25. The Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings Environmental 26. Control Board proposes to amend 48 RCNY Section 3-126, 27. the Water Penalty Schedule, to delegate to the Commissioner 28. of the Department of Environmental Protection its authority to 29. establish a schedule of civil penalties in accordance with 30. Section 24-346 (b) of the Administrative Code of the City of New 31. York. Pursuant to this amendment, OATH ECB will repeal its Water 32. Penalty Schedule, currently found at 48 RCNY Section 3-126. At the 33. same time, DEP will enact a penalty schedule within its own rules at 34. Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York, so that the penalty 35. schedule is relocated to the rules of the agency with primary 36. rulemaking and policymaking jurisdiction over the laws underlying 37. the violations. The proposed amendment of 48 RCNY Section 3-126 38. continues the effort to repeal penalty schedules from the rules of 39. OATH ECB. Although OATH ECB is empowered to impose penalties 40. under Section 1049-a of the New York City Charter and Section 41. 24-346 of the Administrative Code, the regulatory and enforcement 42. agencies have the expertise to determine appropriate penalties 43. based on the severity of each violation and its effect on city 44. residents. Moving the Water Penalty Schedule will also make it easier 45. for the public to find the penalties, which will be located within the 46.

Finally, the amendment will speed up the 48. rulemaking process by eliminating the need for approval by OATH 49. ECB of proposed or amended penalties for the violations of agency **50**. rules that have already gone through the City Administrative 51. Procedure Act rulemaking process. The delegation of authority will **52**. not affect the right of the public to comment during the rulemaking **53**. process. Please note that deleted material is in brackets. Shall and must denote mandatory requirements and 56. may be used interchangeably in the rules of this department, unless **57**. otherwise specified or unless the context clearly indicates otherwise. 58. The proposed rule was published in The City Record on **59**. February 12, 2025. OATH e-mailed the rule to the Speaker of 60. the City Council; every member of the City Council; all community 61. board members: the news media; as well as civic organizations. 62. In addition, OATH posted the proposed rule on OATH's website; the 63. New York City Rules website, and The City Record online website. 64. OATH has been accepting written comments on the proposed rule 65. since the date it was published in The City Record and will 66. continue to accept written comments through the close of business 67. 68. today.
