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Reporting Cause of Death in NYC

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The NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) Bureau of Vital Statistics (BVS) would like to alert you to available **resources on completing cause of death on NYC death certificates.**

- A free online training course, Improving Cause of Death (COD) Reporting eLearning, is available on the DOHMH website and is required for all users of eVital. This training covers how to accurately complete the COD section, when to refer cases to the Office of Chief Medical Examiner, and the importance of accurate COD data.
