OLR plans to select a vendor on the basis of factors stated in the Negotiated Acquisition solicitation document which include, but are not limited to: the respondent's experience, organizational capability and program approach to providing the services described in the Negotiated Acquisition solicitation document.

The anticipated term of the contract with OLR for dependent eligibility audit services is anticipated to be from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2028.
