24 Unavoidable, Significant, Adverse Impacts

According to the 2014 *CEQR Technical Manual*, unavoidable, significant, adverse impacts are those that would occur if a proposed project or action is implemented regardless of the mitigation employed, or if mitigation is infeasible.

As described in **Chapter 7**, *Historical and Cultural Resources*, and **Chapter 10**, *Hazardous Materials*, the Proposed Actions could result in significant, adverse impacts with respect to archaeological resources and hazardous materials. However, as presented in **Chapter 21**, *Mitigation*, no practicable mitigation measures were identified that would reduce or eliminate these impacts. Therefore, the Proposed Actions would result in the potential for unavoidable adverse impacts with respect to archaeological resources and hazardous materials.
