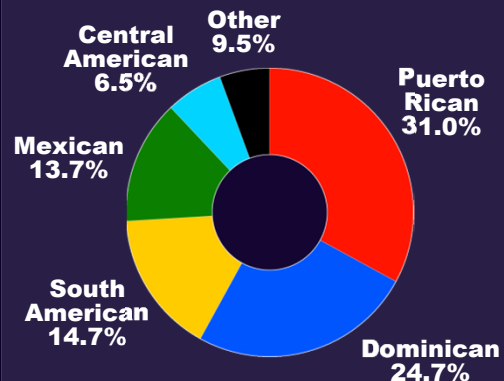


Distribution of Hispanic Groups In Selected Neighborhoods* New York City, 2010

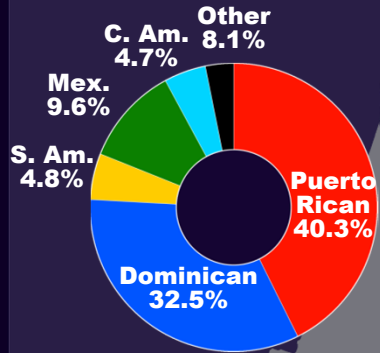

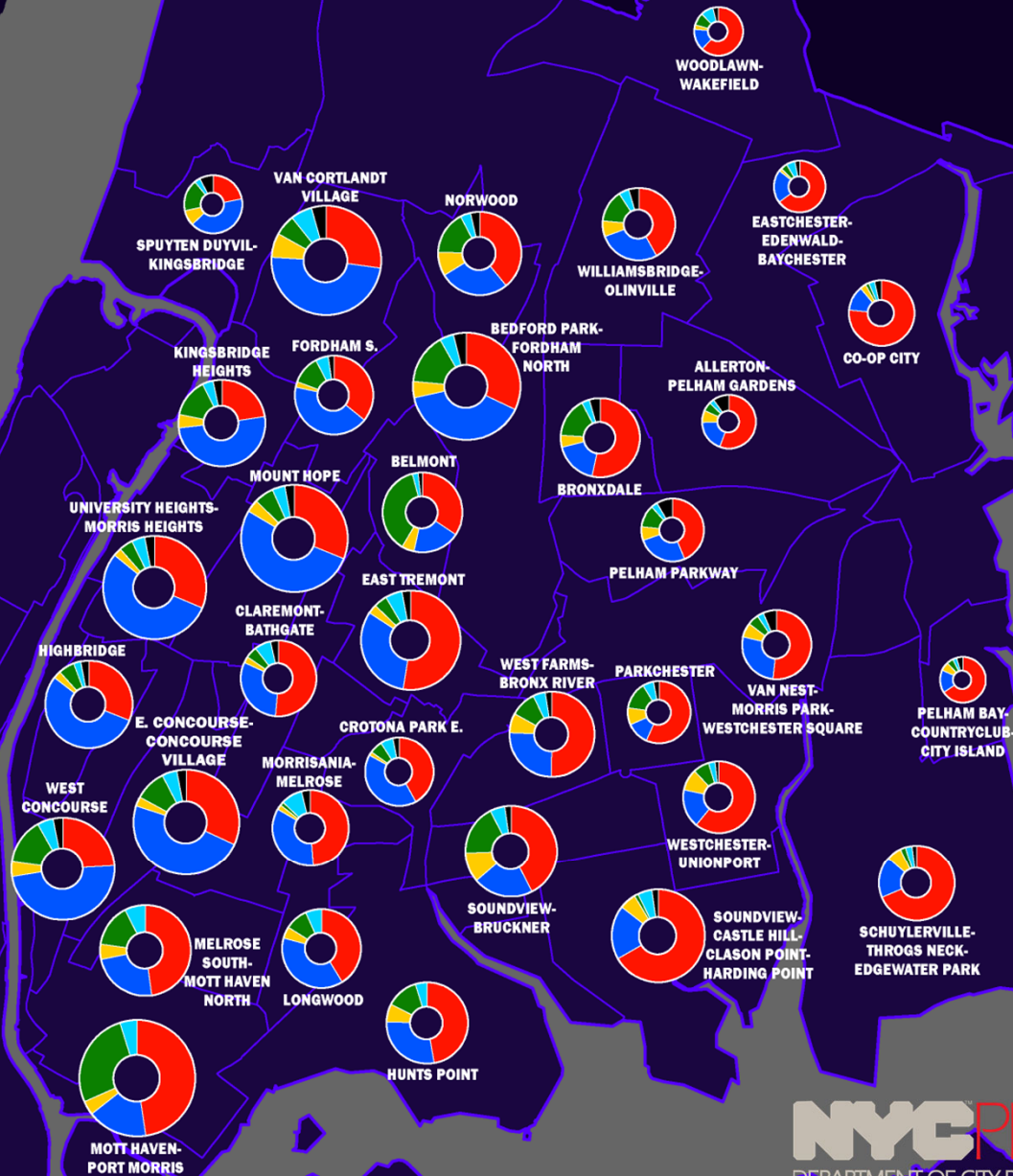
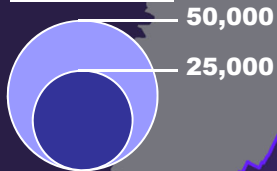
Distribution of Hispanic Groups In Selected Neighborhoods The Bronx, 2010

The Bronx



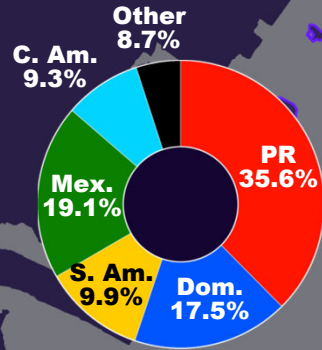

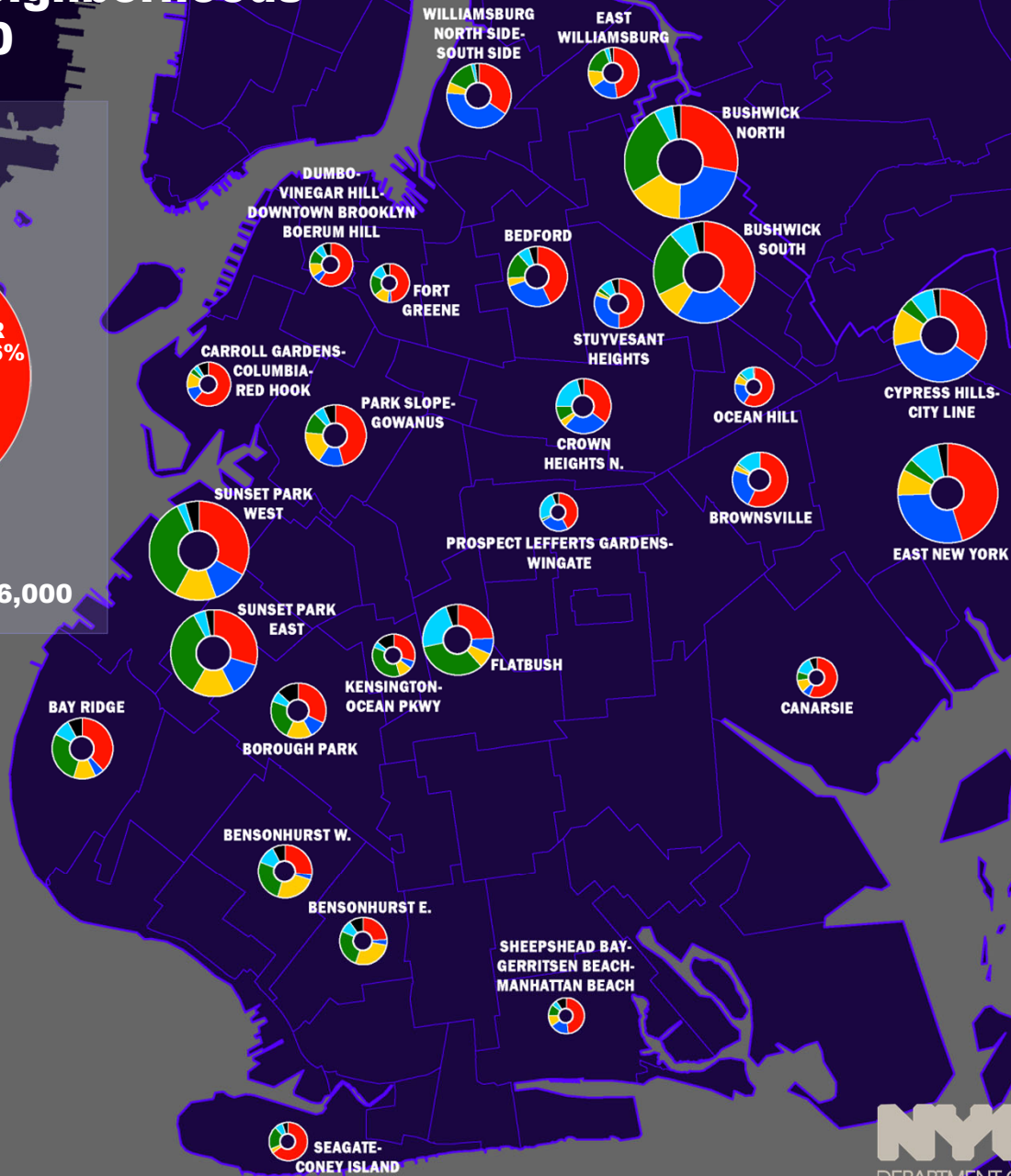
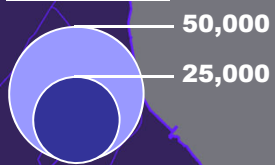
Distribution of Hispanic Groups In Selected Neighborhoods Brooklyn, 2010

Brooklyn



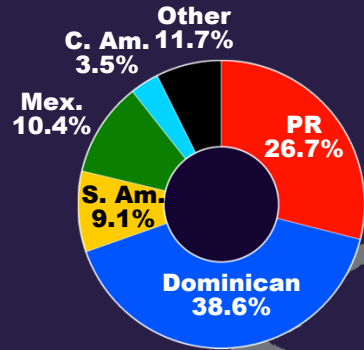

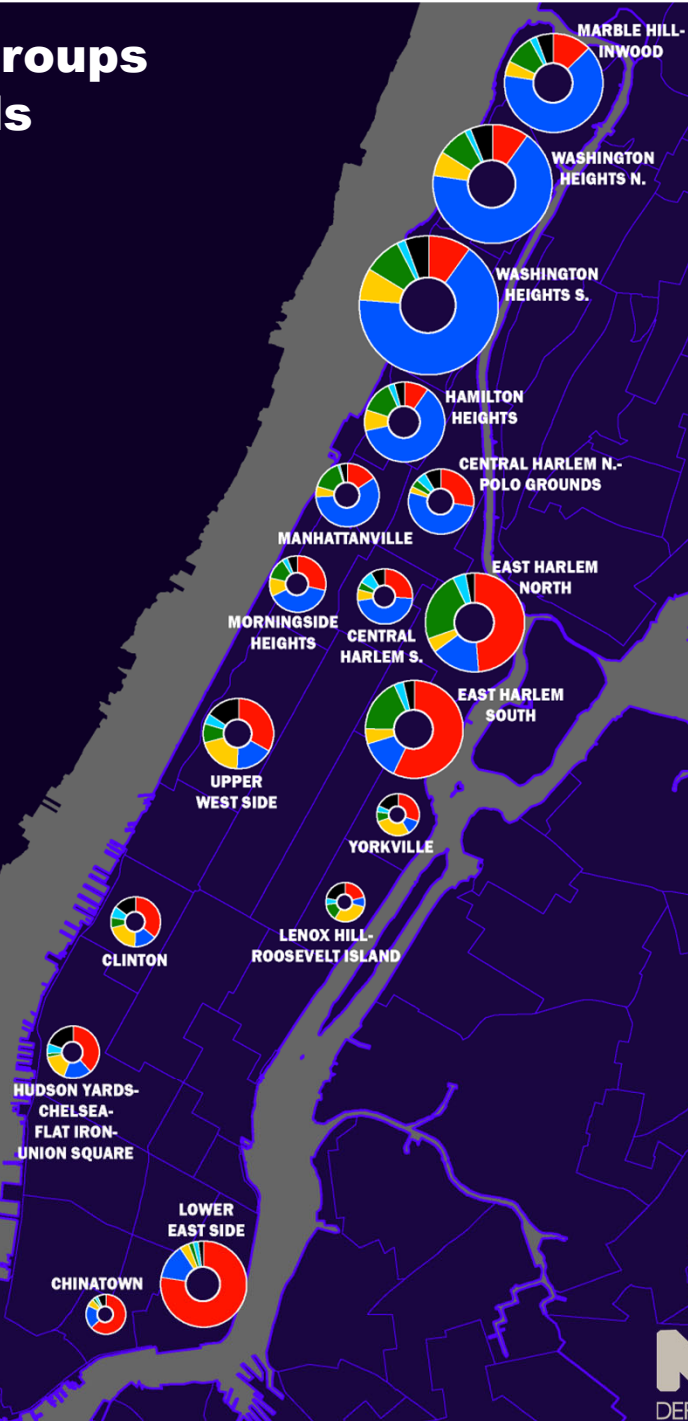
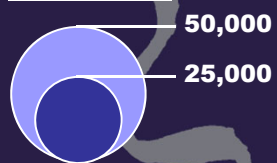
Distribution of Hispanic Groups In Selected Neighborhoods Manhattan, 2010

Manhattan



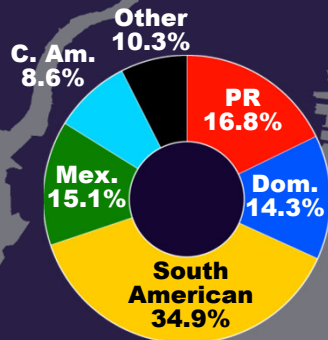

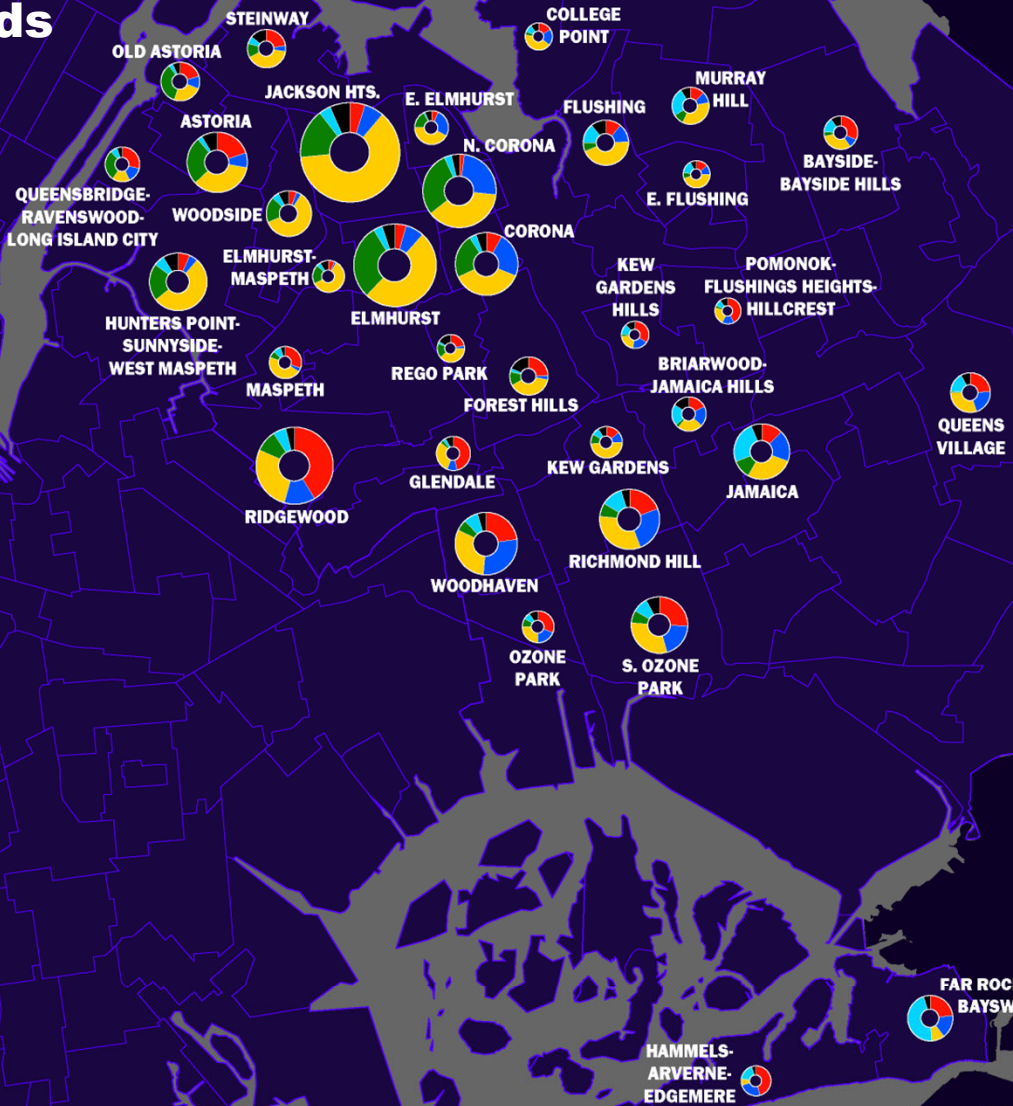
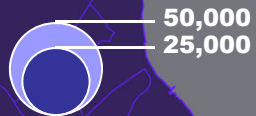
Distribution of Hispanic Groups In Selected Neighborhoods Queens, 2010

Queens Total



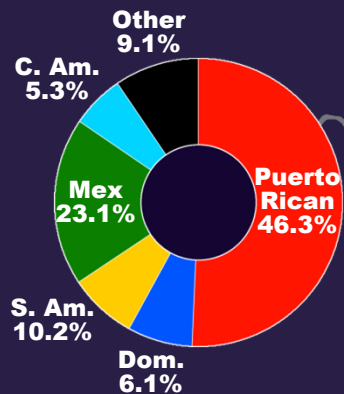

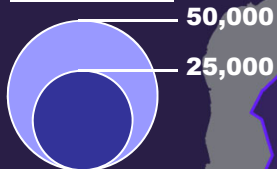
Distribution of Hispanic Groups In Selected Neighborhoods Staten Island, 2010
