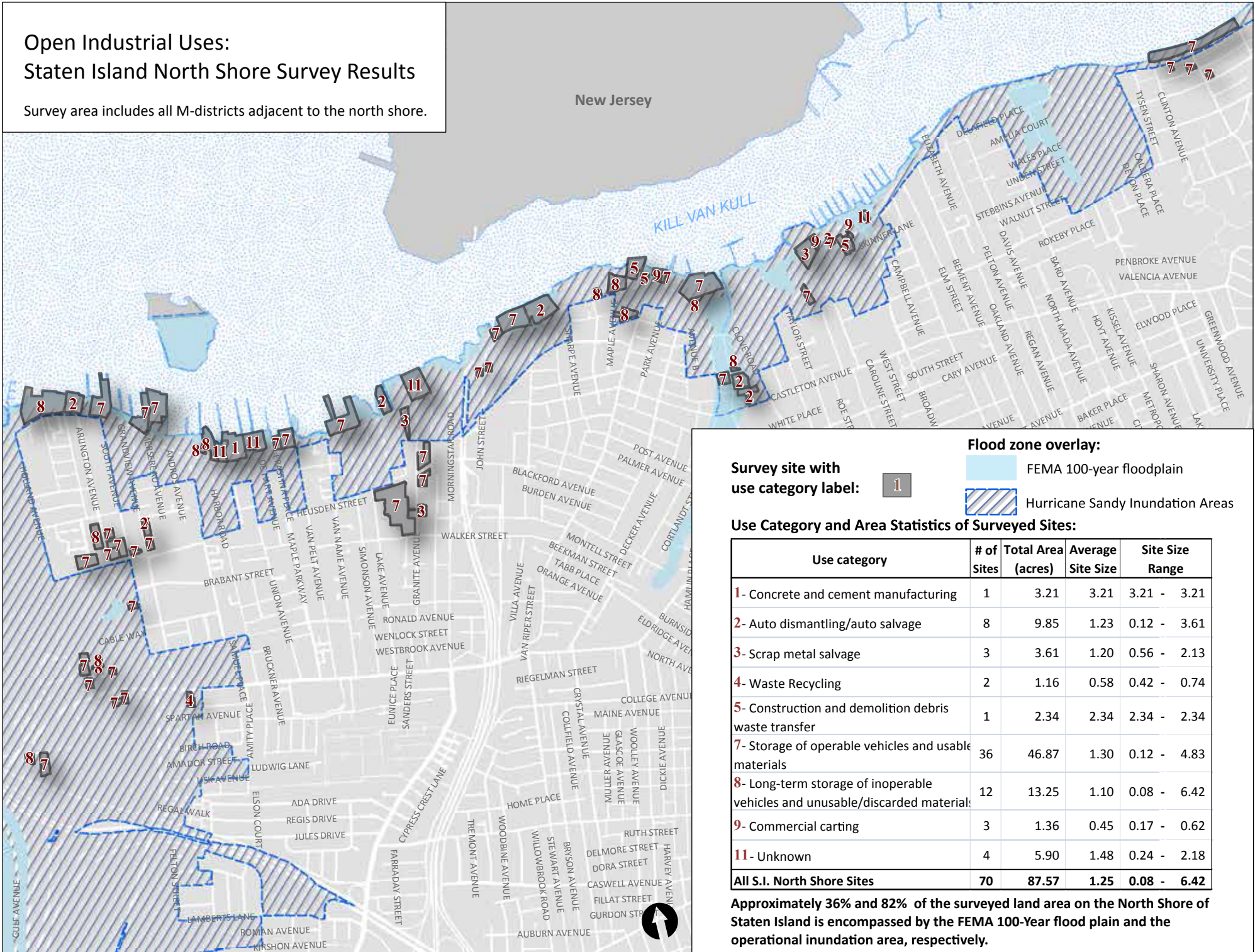


# Open Industrial Uses: Staten Island North Shore Survey Results
