CONDITIONAL Release

Conditional Release is an alternative to incarceration. Individuals who are granted release must serve a period of one (1) year of supervision provided by the NYC Department of Probation.

ELEGIBILITY Requirements

Individuals are eligible if :

- Current sentence is between 120 and 365 days and have already served 60 days or more.
- Their current sentence is for a misdemeanor or low level or non-violent felony.
- They have community ties.

Community Ties: are the relationships and bonds between individuals, their family, and their community.

Examples of community ties are:

- Job or potential of a job once released;
- A stable housing situation;
- Close ties with family members; or
- Relationship with a community institution, such as a church, a school, a former employer.

A P L I C A T I O N P R O C E S S

Applications can be obtained at the law library and intake.

Application must include the following:

- Personal history (name, date of birth, etc.)
- Proposed residence
- Education
- Community ties
- Employment history
- Personal statement

Individuals must submit a full and accurate completed application to the Conditional Release Commission (CRC)

The CRC will make a determination within 30 days of receipt of application.
