The safety and well-being of our community is our primary concern; therefore, the March 17th, 2020 community board meeting is cancelled. As there were no public hearing items or votes scheduled, it is unlikely to be rescheduled.

Governor Cuomo declared a "state of emergency" in New York in response to the ongoing COVID-19 situation. Part of the Governor's order suspends the requirements under the Open Meetings Law for in-person attendance by members of public bodies, which includes Community Boards. Moving forward, until the order is lifted, Community Board meetings and hearings may be held by videoconference and/or teleconference. Community Board 1 Queens will be developing and implementing a plan to hold upcoming meetings and hearings remotely. As soon as this is up and running, we will share it with you. You will be notified of any future scheduling changes as they occur.
