Item # 1: Department of Transportation presentation:
As part of the Truck Route Network Redesign, DOT plans to make truck route changes to Astoria Blvd from 21st St to 29th St. These planned changes will support efforts to keep larger trucks off narrow residential streets adjacent to Astoria Blvd and facilitate commercial vehicle access to/from the RFK Bridge.

DOT is proposing safety enhancements to complement these respective changes, including implementation of traffic calming at high-crash intersections, adding pedestrian safety enhancements throughout the corridor, and improving curb management to reduce instances of double-parking near commercial land uses.

Item # 2: A presentation will be made regarding The QueensLink. The QueensLink is a proposal to create the first north-south subway line in Queens by extending the M train south from Rego Park to Ozone Park and then going over the A train tracks to the Rockaways. A new study assesses its potential economic and environmental impact for the County.
