On Tuesday, January 21, 2025, the CB11 Public Relations met via Zoom to discuss and refine an agenda of committee projects proposed by committee members. Ms. Martino opened the meeting at 7:35 pm and welcomed the participants.

A short, preliminary discussing ensued among committee members on a report Ms. Martino distributed to board members, Joe Marziliano, district manager and Paul DiBenedetto, board chair, issued by the New York Department of City Planning (DCP) on NYC Storefront Corridors and Activity. Ms. Martino stated the committee will focus on this topic and the report at the next committee meeting.

Ms. Martino congratulated the committee for it success with the Douglaston Winter Festival in December and the CB11 Get-Together at 'Erawan Restaurant' in Bayside in early January. Committee members raised awareness of how community boards can help community members and engaged with each other at our own get-together.

Mr. Turner followed through with plans for the next 'community/CB11 awareness "pop-up" at eh Bayside Library on Northern Blvd., off Bell Blvd. on February 8th. He had coordinated with the librarian=s and secured a large room for the event.

Ms. Mazza spoke about the idea of holding a 'Women's Breakfast' at the New York Center For Women, in Fort Totten. She educated us on the work of the center, which a number of CB11 board members support. The Center provides support to the only Women's Shelter in our district and is close to our district. Ms. Martino aid she will follow up with both the Center and CB11 executive teams for consensus and next steps, before moving forward.

Mr. Hadjiconstantinou suggested that he would like us to host another blood drive at the same venue, if possible, Korean Community Services, and including a church group or groups to amplify participation. Ms. Martino said she will follow up after checking with all of the stakeholders. Ms. Martino also said she will follow up with the full committee to see if others were interested in volunteering for any of these projects.

Mr. Turner asked if the Library event could by added to the board's social media accounts. Mr. Marziliano said that if he received a flyer for the event, he will add it.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
