The NYC Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) is the city agency responsible for licensing and regulating New York City's yellow and green taxis, for hire vehicles, commuter vans, and paratransit vehicles.

TLC's Accessible Dispatch Program provides wheelchair accessible yellow and green taxi service to passengers whose trips originate anywhere in the five boroughs and end in the five boroughs, Westchester County, Nassau County, or any of New York City's three regional airports.
