Heap Benefits

The Heap application deadline for the season has been extended from March 15, 2021 until April 30, 2021 (or until the funds are exhausted). A second Heap Emergency benefit for heat related emergencies was made available as of March 8, 2021. The household will be evaluated for an emergency benefit and, if eligible, may receive an emergency benefit concurrently with their regular Heap benefit.

Snap Application

Clients, providers, and advocates can now call into the info line to request a paper copy of the Simplified Snap Application Kit (LDSS-5166) by mail. Applicants can only be used by households where:

- All adults are 60 years or older or have a disability.
- No adult in the household has earned income.
