June is Black Music Month!

Community Board 12 Queens continues to have the highest numbers of foreclosures in the borough of Queens. Applicants for the One-Shot Deal Emergency Grants for rent arrears are no longer required to apply for Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) to be eligible for a grant from HRA. This does not change with the re-opening of the ERAP portal.

Households eligible for rental arrears may also be eligible for help paying utility means at the same rental unit.

Those who are at risk of eviction may be eligible for free legal assistance through HRA's Office of Civil Justice.

The ERAP call center operates Monday through Friday from 9am-7pm. The call center can assist anyone who has a question about applying for ERAP. The numbers for the call center are:
