Land Use Committee - Chair Michael Mallia, Vice Chair Steven Taylor: BSA Calendar Number 268-03-BZ

- > 145-55 Guy R. Brewer Boulevard.
- > Extension of term for variance.
- The Land Use Committee voted 9-0 to approve this item with conditions.
- Hiram Rothkrug, facilitator of this item for the applicant, sent a letter to QCB13 agreeing to the conditions and agreeing to work with the community board going forward.
- Motion to approve application by BM Richard Hellenbrecht. Seconded by BM David Pecoraro.
- > Roll Call vote: 35 yes, 0 No, 0 Abstaining.

# Land Swap between Yeshiva Har Torah and School Yard behind PS18Q (The Winchester School)

- After some background from Casey x of Council Member Lee's Office and a longstanding member of the Board at the Yeshiva, lively debate ensued on this issue.
- Ultimately the Land Use Committee took a vote to support the Land Swap:
  - o 7 Yes, 2 No.
  - The DM will draft a letter to Council Member Lee indicating the Community Board's support for the land swap.

#### Parks & Environment Committee – Committee Chair Fay Hill:

- Still working on getting a dog run.
- Committee Chair spoke with Parks manager Justin Argo on what was not done in Brookville Park on Memorial Day weekend.
  - o Parks workers did not clean up.
- There seems to be problems with the mowing of grass at the corner of Brookville Boulevard and 147 Avenue.
- ➤ The barbeque area of Springfield Pard will be closed beginning July 11 to restore this heavily used area,

#### Public Safety - Committee Chair Michael O'Keeffe and Vice Chair Robert Glover:

- August 2, 2022 is "National Night Out Against Crime".
- Two liquor license applications; both were approved.
- NYPD Sergeant Taormina alert the 105 Precinct if portable toilets are put on the street or if something is seen on social media about a backyard party.
  - NYPD has limited power over backyard parties but there are some things they can do.
- > 180 Street & 145 Drive a squatter house:
  - o After 30 days it is difficult to remove people.

**Combined Youth, Education & Libraries Committee & Health Committee** – Committee Chair Rhonda Kontner and Vice Chair Lorraine Gittens-Bridges & Chair Bonnie Huie:

- > Guest Speaker: Dr. Vera Fauer "The State of Mental Health for Children"
  - Cohen Children's Hospital has a Mental Health Program in the Emergency Room at Northwell Long Island Jewish Medical Center.
- > One of the schools at Campus Magnet is changing its name without complying with NYC Department of Education regulations.
  - Looking to convene an Emergency Meeting in July to demand community input in this process.

#### **Transportation Committee** –Vice Chair Sophia Mighty:

- Presentation by DOT on Hempstead Avenue Safety Project.
  - Transportation Committee unanimously voted to support these improvements.
  - o QCB13 to write a letter of support.

**Seniors, Social Services & Special Needs –** Committee Chair Kangela Moore and Vice Chair Tanya Cruz:

> Tried to have a year-end social but no one showed up.
