Important Notice

The NYCDOT Division of Bridges has initiated lead paint removal and protective coating operations on the Borden Avenue Bridge over Dutch Kills in Queens. Beginning on or about **Monday, July 3,** <u>eastbound</u> Borden Avenue between 27th Avenue and Review Avenue will be <u>reduced to one travel</u> lane, and "No Parking" restrictions will be in place. Additionally, the <u>sidewalk on the south side of the bridge will be reduced to 5 feet in width</u>. This traffic pattern will be in place 24/7 for approximately 3 weeks.



Beginning Monday, July 3 (no work will take place on July 4)
Eastbound Borden Avenue between 27th Avenue and Review Avenue

- · Reduced to one travel lane
- "No Parking" restrictions in place
- · South sidewalk reduced to 5 feet in width
