Important Notice

The NYCDOT Division of Bridges has initiated lead paint removal and protective coating operations on the **Borden Avenue Bridge over Dutch Kills** in Queens. **Beginning on Wednesday, November 8** for approximately 6 weeks, Borden Avenue (between 27th Avenue and Review Avenue) will be **reduced to one travel lane**, and a one-way operation will be in effect with flaggers alternating the flow of traffic. This traffic pattern will be in place during the following hours:

- **Monday through Friday: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**
- **Saturday and Sunday: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

Motorists may use Hunters Point Avenue as an alternate route to bypass the construction zone.
