# Important Notice

The NYCDOT Division of Bridges has initiated lead paint removal and protective coating operations on the **Borden Avenue Bridge over Dutch Kills** in Queens. Borden Avenue (between 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Review Avenue) will be reduced to one travel lane from 9:00 p.m. (on Friday evenings) through 9:00 p.m. (on Sunday evenings) on four consecutive weekends: Friday, 9/15 through Sunday, 9/17; Friday, 9/22 through Sunday, 9/24; Friday, 9/29 through Sunday, 10/1; and Friday, 10/6 through Sunday, 10/8. A one-way operation will be in effect, and flaggers will alternate the flow of traffic. Motorists may use Hunters Point Avenue as an alternate route to bypass the construction zone.
